- After clearing passport control, collecting your luggage and passing through customs, you will meet with your Tour Manager and transfer to the city center.
- With your tour manager, enjoy a panoramic tour of Madrid and take a ride on the Teleferico, Madrid's Cable Car.
 - Travel above the city's parks and the Manzanares River as a recorded commentary describes what you are seeing. See many of the famous sights such as Parque del Oeste, the Royal Palace, the Buen Retiro Park, the Almudena Cathedral, Puerta del Sol, Puerta de Alcalà, Plaza Mayor, the Museum District (with Museo del Prado, Museo Reina Sofía, Museo Thyssen-Bornemisza, the Science Museum and many more).
- At the end of the tour, check in at the hotel in Madrid.
- Time permitting – group rehearsal before or after dinner.

- Lunch on your own
- After lunch, continue to Segovia.
 - Segovia is a World Heritage city with a famous Aqueduct constructed in Roman times, a major Cathedral and Medieval Alcazar (Palace). Enjoy a guided city tour starting from the majestic Roman Aqueduct.
- Return to Madrid at the conclusion of the tour.
- Dinner provided this evening.
- Overnight in Madrid

DAY 5 **Tuesday, July 19, 2022**

Madrid/Seville

(Meals: B & D)

- Breakfast at your accommodations and check out
- Transfer by motor coach to Seville.
- Arrive in Seville, one of the most culturally rich and diverse cities in the Iberian Peninsula.
- Time for the group to get their own lunch near the hotel with your tour managers' assistance.
- This afternoon meet your local guide in the hotel lobby.
 - Go behind the scenes of the cult 'Game of Thrones' HBO TV series on this 2-hour walking tour in Seville — Explore the Alcázar of Seville palace that doubles as the Water Gardens of Dorne, the seat of House Martell, in season five. Roam the pool-dotted grounds that served as the Water Gardens themselves and hear insider gossip about the series.

- After breakfast, continue your tour of Seville.
- Visit the Cathedral of Santa Maria, the largest cathedral in Spain, where Christopher Columbus is buried and his tomb is always of great interest to visitors.
- The Giralda Tower is an ancient Arabic minaret and symbol of the city, dominating the city skyline. This magnificent structure has been used as inspiration for similar architecture in Rabat and Marrakech.
- You will end the tour with a pleasant stroll through Santa Cruz, Seville's historic Jewish quarter. With narrow cobbled streets winding among white washed buildings, this is the most picturesque area of the city.
- Enjoy some free time to shop and wander explore the city.
 - Seville means flamenco, tapas, bullfights, and parties - all that embodies the essence of Spain. You will be able to discover the ancient neighborhoods, their narrow streets, and the tranquility of the parks. Seville has a rich architectural heritage, including a marvelous Cathedral, the Giralda and the Reales Alcazares. Walk along the Guadalquivir River, currently Spain's only river port, which divides the city in two.
